- Joe Carlson (EPA Regional) has funded ORELAP to \$10K for TNI training.
- The goal is to get all auditors certified for all tests.
- REPORT GENERATION: Out of state labs take longer. 3<sup>rd</sup> party assessors make for longer reporting due to the required back-n-forth between them and ORELAP.
- ORELAP is hitting 5 labs per month to maintain the 24 month cycle for all labs.
- DRINKING WATER is forwarding complaints to Stephanie about lab reports not meeting specifications. This is taking up a lot of ORELAP time.
- There has been no move on rule making ----- the RAC has not been used ---- yet(?).
- Stephanie was asked (again) to provide OELA with an EXCEL or CSD Spreadsheet of the accredited labs in the state so that OELA can disseminate information and make an easily searchable data base for OELA members. The information is currently available on the ORELAP website, but not easily searchable.
